

Major Scales

Horn in F

This sheet of music contains 11 staves, each representing a major scale for the Horn in F instrument. The scales are written in 4/4 time and are presented in the following order from top to bottom:

- Scale 1: F Major (one flat: Bb)
- Scale 2: G Major (no sharps or flats)
- Scale 3: A Major (no sharps or flats)
- Scale 4: Bb Major (two flats: Bb, Eb)
- Scale 5: C Major (no sharps or flats)
- Scale 6: D Major (two sharps: F#, C#)
- Scale 7: Eb Major (three flats: Bb, Eb, Ab)
- Scale 8: E Major (three sharps: F#, C#, G#)
- Scale 9: F Major (one flat: Bb)
- Scale 10: G Major (no sharps or flats)
- Scale 11: A Major (no sharps or flats)

Each scale is written as a single melodic line on a five-line staff, starting on the first line (C4) and ending on the first line of the next octave (C5). The notes are quarter notes, and the scales are written in a standard ascending and descending format.
