MENTORSHIP PROGRAM GENERAL SCHEDULE



The Mentorship Program is a two-year process. Learning takes place through retreats, large group seminars, reading, discussion, small group mentorship circles, and individual mentorship.

MENTORSHIP CIRCLES

Individuals will be paired with a mentor and 1-3 other participants. Mentorship Circles will meet outside formal gatherings (either in person or online via video conferencing) once a month for shared prayer, application of session content, and individualized coaching around particular areas of personal growth. Brief individual check-ins with mentors will take place 1-2 times each month.

YEAR 1

Year 1 focuses on imparting the vision, knowledge, and skills that serve as a foundation for effective evangelization and parish renewal. The schedule includes:

- Regular seminars (day-long sessions including presentations, small group discussion, etc.)
- Individual learning in preparation for seminars. May be asked to watch videos, complete reading (approximately 1 book or 3 articles per month), listen to a podcast, write a short reflection, etc.
- Overnight fall and spring retreats
- Mentorship Circle gatherings every month (in person or via video conferencing) with specific tasks for application of seminar content

YEAR 2

Year 2 focuses on imparting the vision, experiences, and practical skills for making and multiplying disciples. The schedule includes:

- Regular seminars (day-long sessions including presentations, small group discussion, etc.)
- Individual learning in preparation for seminars. May be asked to watch videos, complete reading (approximately 1 shorter book or 3 articles per month), write a short reflection, etc.
- Overnight fall and spring retreats
- Mentorship Circle gatherings every month (in person or via video conferencing) with specific tasks for application of seminar content
- Completion of a Disciple-Making Action Plan (discerned with guidance from mentors)

THE FOLLOWING PAGES CONTAIN A GENERAL SCHEDULE OF THE SESSIONS. PLEASE NOTE:

- Exact dates, locations, and times will be finalized by May for the coming year's sessions (August-April).
- Session topics are subject to change with continued program development.
- In order to accommodate individuals across the Archdiocese, participants are divided into two cohorts (one Metro and one Rural). The schedule specifies the following:
 - August, September, October, February, March, and April are sessions where both cohorts meet together on one Saturday in the same location.
 - November and January sessions are duplicated (one Saturday in the metro area and another Saturday in the rural area). Participants may attend either date according to their schedule.
